Dear NCLS Parents,

NO SCHOOL on the coming Sunday, April 12, 2009 and we will resume our class on the Sunday, April 19, 2009. There are a couple important issues we would like to address.

1. Classroom Rules and Misconducts

Last two weeks, our school had received a couple very serious complaints from Day School teachers and Day School administrators for the misconducts of a couple of our students inside the classrooms. We urgently ask our parents to work with your child or children to follow the school classroom rules, such as only write on your own book or paper or black board (class use only), do not write or paint on anything else which belongs to the classroom, and do not touch anything in the classroom except the table and chair which are for class use only. Especially, do not touch the classroom teacher's desk or take away any personal belonging from the teacher's desk or drawers, such as candy and money (coins). There is absolutely NO FOOD in the classroom.

The school administration will work with teachers and TAs to enforce the classroom rules aggressively and we have no tolerance for any violation of the classroom rules. Just keep in mind, any of those misconducts may result losing the classroom and school.

Students cannot enter the classroom until the classroom teacher or TA is in the classroom, especially for those science classrooms.

2. Outside the Building

We had received a call from the Parks and Recreation Department of Newton regarding the fields outside of Day School building. We (NCLS) are only renting the classrooms inside the Day School building, not any field out of the building. If you like to use any of those fields, you should have permission from the Parks and Recreation Department of Newton. Here is the contact information for using the field: contact person: Mr. Cahil, Phone: (617) 796-1500. Especially when the ground is wet, the owner may not allow anyone to play in the field to avoid any damage on the field. Please ask for your permission, if you want to use the field.
