

1. How do I register for NCLS?

If you are new to our school, please create your family account online at:

Please follow the instruction and enter the head of the household/parents info first. You can always add new member to your NCLS account. Do **NOT** enter your children's information as the head of the household/parents. Please enter all the correct information including your name, phone number, email, home address, birth date and year.

Note: Please make sure your email address in your account is up to date so you can receive our weekly newsletter which includes program updates, exams, activities, class/school cancelations, etc. You can also [click here](#) to check all the current and previous newsletters, and sign it up.

2. How do I find “The Course Select” page?

After logging into your NCLS account, simply click the student's name (blue English name), then you will get into that page.

You will see 3 class sessions (drop down lists) as below. You can select your desired class from each class session.

1st class session 12:30PM – 1:50PM

2nd class session 2PM – 3:30PM

3rd class session 3:40pm – 5PM

Note: private lesson is available by request. Higher tuition fee may apply.

Special classes have starting and ending time in the class names.

4. Are there any differences between class A, B, and C of the same grade?

There are no differences! All classes use the same textbook, same teaching plan, and students take the same exams.

5. How much is the Tuition fee?

Tuition per semester (16 weeks):

Chinese language courses: Starting from \$165 (1st class session \$165, 2nd and 3rd class \$175)

Singapore math courses: Starting from \$145 (1st class session \$145, 3rd class \$155)

Other classes: \$145 and up

Tuition for senior students \$50

Registration Fee \$10

Private/small group class or special courses tuition may vary. Check details in registration in your account for all small group and/or special courses.

The cost for textbooks is NOT included in the tuition.

Please note: A seat is reserved only after the registration is complete and the tuition is paid in full.

Discount

If the total tuition per student equals or exceeds \$310, you will receive a \$35 discount. This price applies to both children and adult courses.

Once you have finished the course selection, the system will show the total amount you have to pay.

6. How do I make the payment?

Please select the following payment methods.

Please note: A seat is reserved only after the registration is complete and the tuition is paid in full. Payment arrives after the 1st school day, September 10th would be considered late payment. A late payment fee may apply.
