Information for the Sping Semester Registration

Registration Timeline:

- Registration for the Spring Semester will start on Jan 2nd. There are two registration time periods:
 - ½ 5/31: Registration open to current students only
 - \circ 1/9 5/31: Registration open for all
- Your seat in a class won't be reserved without full tuition paid.
- You will not be able to register for any fall class if there is:
 - o any outstanding balance, or
 - o overdue parents' duty in your family account.
- Registration fee is \$20 **per family account**, but it will be waived if all account balance is paid on or before 1/16. After Jan 16th, \$20 registration fee will be added to your account automatically.

Class Schedule:

- The NCLS Spring Semester 2024 starts on January 28th, 2024 and ends June 23rd, 2024.
- There are 3 in person sessions (classes) on Sundays:
 - o First session: 12:30PM-1:50PM
 - Second session: 2:00PM-3:30PM
 - o Third session: 3:40 PM-5:00 PM
- There are 2 online sessions (classes) on Saturdays:
 - o First session: 2:00PM-3:30PM
 - o Second session: 3:40 PM-5:00 PM

Tuitions, Textbook Fee, and Discounts:

- The tuition is for one semester of 16 classes (weekends).
- The textbook cost is not covered in the tuition. You need to select "add the text book" when you register for a language or a math class.
- Tuition for Chinese language courses: \$236 (for 80 minutes classes) and \$246 (for 90 minutes classes).
- Tuition for Singapore math courses: \$236 (for 80 minutes classes)
- Fees for other courses vary by course. You will see detailed fee schedules when you register.

• If a student's total tuition is equal or greater than \$360, the student will get a \$35 discount.
